A Fasnacht's Waggis brings colourful jest and cheer into the crowd dancing away the winter, spinning in meditative dervish circles, playing jovial notes from the flute, welcoming the spring. A blazing sun in the summer triggers the glacial melts in the mountains, trickles of water become streams, rivulets and rivers, watering planes and fields. With the onset of a new season, new growths and life arises, a new avatar appears, discarding the excesses of festivities, frivolities and consumption, ridding itself of excess materiality with austerity and discipline, performing yogic salutations to the sun in Surya Namaskars with the Surya mantra, ending in a calm meditation at the foothills of the mountains.


